## WHAT IS IT?

ArcAhead is a pioneering initiative designed to enable current users of Augmented Reality welding simulators to upgrade their ageing equipment while simultaneously contributing to social equity, workforce development, and environmental sustainability.



## HOW DOES IT WORK?

By upgrading to the latest Soldamatic 6.0 augmented reality welding simulators, participants not only receive a 15% discount on new hardware but also take part in a meaningful social impact project.

Rather than returning legacy simulators to the manufacturer, Weld Australia works collaboratively with customers to donate these units to underprivileged or Indigenous schools and communities, introducing welding as a career pathway and supporting Australia's growing demand for skilled welders.

Simulators are cleaned, refurbished if necessary, and delivered along with awareness support and introductory training sessions. These communities use the simulators to:

- Host "Come & Try Welding" events
- Offer basic welding exposure to students
- Promote welding as a career path

We'll collaborate with you to nominate a community or school to receive your legacy simulators.



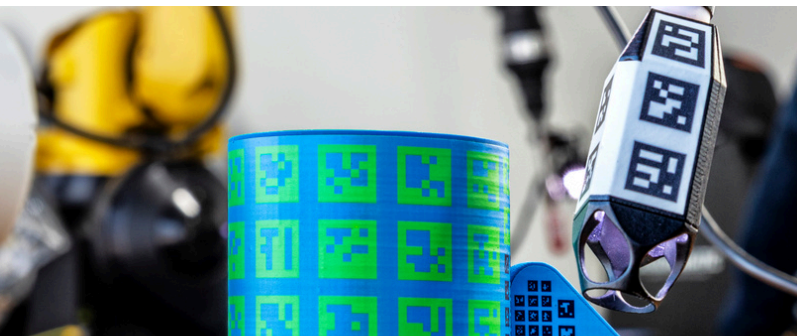
### Step 4: Equipment Handover
