Outline how your company ensures quality in all its work, as well as health and safety performance. Consider factors such as qualifications and certifications, and policies and procedures.

Innovation & Problem Solving (500 words maximum)

Outline how the nominee demonstrates innovation in pipe fabrication. This may include the use of new technologies, automation, improved fabrication methods, or the ability to solve complex technical challenges.

Contribution to the Broader Industry (500 words maximum)

Outline how the nominee contributes to the broader industry. This may include training and mentoring, apprenticeships, knowledge sharing, participation in industry initiatives, or supporting the development of future skills.

Other Qualities and Pursuits (300 words maximum) - *Optional*

Please include any other information that may be relevant to the award, such as the company's involvement in community activities, industry activities, and other awards and achievements.
